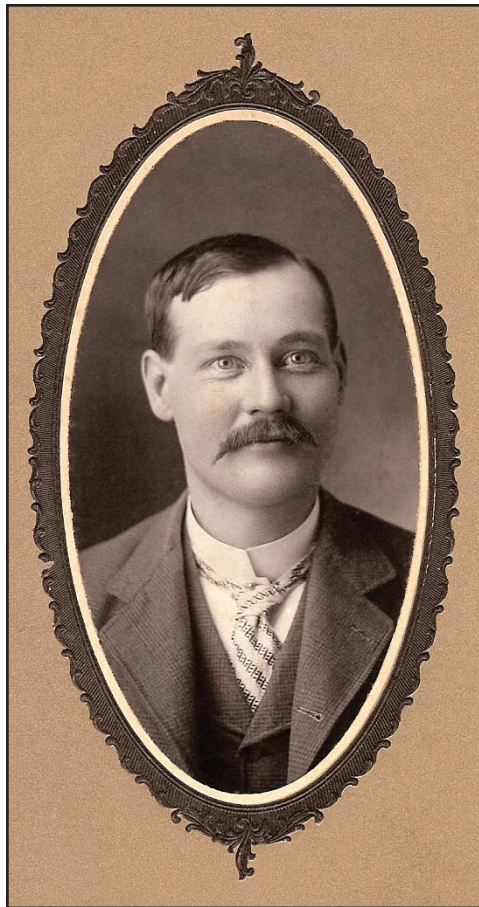

The farm was on top of the quarry, and across the road from the Jacob Hogenson farm.
