 Back Row Left to Right Boys: Jens Pederson Spangrudlien born 1852 (John P. Lien, settled in Park River, ND); Øshen Pedersen Spangrudlien born 1850 (stayed in Norway) married Mari Pederdatter Romsaas; Peder Pedersen Spangrudlien born 1845 (stayed in Norway); Lars Pedersen Spangrudlien born 1848 (Settled in SD); Ola Pedersen Spangrudlien 1854 (Ole P Lien settled near Adams, ND) (my Great- Grandfather).
 Sitting left to right: Anne Spangrudlien 1841 married a Mork, never came to US; Peder Pedersen Spangrudlien 1812 Father, my Great Great Grandfather never came to US; Mali Larsdatter Stenumgaardskleven 1820, Mother, My Great Great Grandmother – never came to US; Barbro Spangrudlien 1843, married Gjelsvik- never came to US. Small children in front standing Left to Right: Martinus Pedersen Spangrudlien 1861 he married a Kaus and moved to that farm-never came to US; Torger Pederson Spangrudlien 1859 (Tom P Lien settled in Garvin, MN); Otto Pederson Spangrudlien 1863 (Otto P Lien) never married died by gas while cleaning a well in Gravin, MN; Mathea Spangrudlien (Martha Hole later Martha Johnson) 1857 married Benjamin Hole came to McIntosh, MN, he worked in Fargo, ND and had to take a train to work every week, they were heard just a month and he came home not feeling well and he died of Typhoid Fever and Martha and her children were left alone.
