Here is the information that you requested.

Great-great grandfather-Christopher Herman..nickname Stoffel, a son of Nichlaus Herman, was born near Coblenz, Germany, in 1827. He came to America in 1846 and stayed in Philadelphia for two years. In 1848 his father and mother came to this country and homesteaded in Jackson, Wisconsin in 1849.

He was married to Ann Faber in 1854. In 1863 he entered the Civil War and served under General ^{Edward J. Tomlinson} Bragg. ^{of} They went into battle shortly after he entered service. Only 17 men of his company survived the war. The last battle that he fought in before the war ended was the Battle of the Wilderness.

After the war he operated a large farm, was insurance insurance for the Germantown Fire Insurance Co. and a trustee of the Washington County Poor Farm. He fathered 13 children, one child died while he was in service. He died in Jackson, Wis., July 19, 1909. His wife died in 1916. His second youngest son Jacob, served in the National Guard during the Spanish American War.

Andrew Herman, Child of Christopher Herman and father of Carlton Herman was born in Jackson November, 1870. He was a farmer all of his life and died in June of 1940.
